There will also be a 25 km and a 50 km bike route.

Walking:

Start from 8am to 2pm

Cycling:

25 km or 50 km Start from 8am to 2pm

Arrival until 5pm.

Worldwide, the Belgian Ardennes are best known for the events of World War II. Despite these tragic episodes, the many forests and rivers have survived. The region has so many waterways that it is also known as Ardenne Bleue (Blue Ardennes). Reinhardstein Castle (picture above) will be admired by marathon participants on our second day.

Swimming (indoor pool):

300m or 500m From 8am to 11am and from 3pm to 5pm.

Cycling:

25 km or 50 km Start from 8am to 2pm and end by 5pm.

Walking:

5 km, 10 km or 23 km Start from 7am to 2pm and end by 5pm.

The High Fens region houses an endangered fauna and flora. Marathon runners will see landscapes that are as unique as stunning.

The 50km route will reach the highest point of Belgium. Did you know that? A six-metre stairway was built here to climb to 700 m altitude.

Brussels South (Charleroi) → 160 km Brussels Airport (Zaventem) → 160 km Düsseldorf (DE) → 150 km Köln-Bonn (DE) → 110 km



Train station in Eupen → 35 km
Train station in Verviers-Central → 40 km

Line 14 from train station in Aachen to train station in Eupen.

Line 394 or express line E23 from the train station in Eupen.

Line 390 from the train station in Verviers-Central

Stop at the bus station "Bütgenbach Kreuzung" → 1.5 km from starting point
